Memphis, Tennessee – December 14, 2007 – Neighborhood Christian Centers (NCC) is accepting donated toys for their annual Christmas Toy Store now through Christmas. Toys may be dropped off at NCC, 785 Jackson Avenue, Monday – Friday 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. and Sunday 11 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Next Thursday, December 20, from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. the NCC Toy Store, at 785 Jackson Avenue, will be open to families, who have pre-registered, to receive at least 3 new toys per family. Toys dropped off after Thursday will still be given to those in need through NCC church affiliates, also to those who have pre-registered.

“Calls for help with the Christmas season have been pouring in,” said NCC’s Administrative Director Ephie Johnson. Although the NCC Toy Store makes it possible for families on the waiting list to come in and shop for their children, not all requests can be met. Each year, NCC opens the Toy Store to help “Neighbors in need” during the Christmas season, but there are not enough donated toys to fulfill the requests.

NCC needs a minimum of 2000 new toys. If you would like to participate in this drive, begin to collect new toys now and we will either pick them up or you can drop them off by December 25th. You can also choose to buy bulk items or contribute to that purchase. Purchasing has been simplified as well; we are registered with Target at www.target.com and Wal-Mart at www.walmart.com.
